



Sickle Cell Disease Educator/Counselor Certification Program April 22—25, 2024 Max: 10 Participants In-person & Eight (8) Virtual



GOALS

The Sickle Cell Certification program was designed to train and certify sickle cell educators and counselors to:

- Provide education and counseling to individuals diagnosed with sickle cell disease and other related hemoglobinopathies.
- Offer education about these disorders to health care professionals, paraprofessionals, as well as to individuals directly affected by sickle cell disease and other interested audiences.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

- Attend all sessions of the 4-day program
- Conduct an educational presentation on sickle cell disease and trait.
- Successfully conduct a mock counseling session under the supervision of program staff.
- Achieve a passing score of 80% or higher on the final examination.
- Re-test must be taken within 3 months if a score of 80% was not achieved on the final exam. Failure to pass the re-test may result in the individual having to re-enroll in the Sickle Cell Certification Program.

- Introduction to genetics: patterns of inheritance and factors influencing geographic distribution
- Hemoglobin & hemoglobinopathies
- Differences between sickle cell trait, sickle cell anemia and sickle cell disease & other hemoglobinopathies
- History & geographic distribution of sickle cell disease
- Introduction to thalassemia
- Pathophysiology & medical management of sickle cell disease
- Diagnostic techniques for the detection of hemoglobinopathies
- Newborn screening for hemoglobinopathies
- Education as a focal point of sickle cell services
- Psychosocial issues related to sickle cell disease
- Sickle cell trait and the athlete
